### Notes:

- The analysis of satisfaction was carried out sporadically among graduates in the past, but we plan to do it on a regular basis in the future in the form of questionnaires.
- VŠM wants to focus on visiting professors from foreign universities as a part of international cooperation, as it has proven to be successful in the past and most recently during the pandemic, when Dr. Imani Silver Kyaruzi, BA, MBA, PhD, SFHEA, FRSA from the University of Birmingham, UK lectured on various subjects.
- Due to the low number of employees, interaction and communication with employees is intensive and this form has proven to be effective.
- It is implemented very intensively in all areas of study and education, we dare to say that we pay more attention to it than the standard since the establishment of VŠM, as VŠM is the first university in Slovakia that formulated and applied the rules of academic ethics and a support system for the detection of plagiarism. It has developed an effective means of combating plagiarism through its academic ethics program. This fact is also confirmed by the To dá rozum project.
- The onset of the global Covid-19 pandemic, VŠM had to respond to the increased demand for online resources, and this trend continues. At the same time, since the academic year 2014/2015, VŠM has provided its students with the possibility of using e-books of Wolter Kluwer, which also influenced the need to purchase physical copies for the library.
